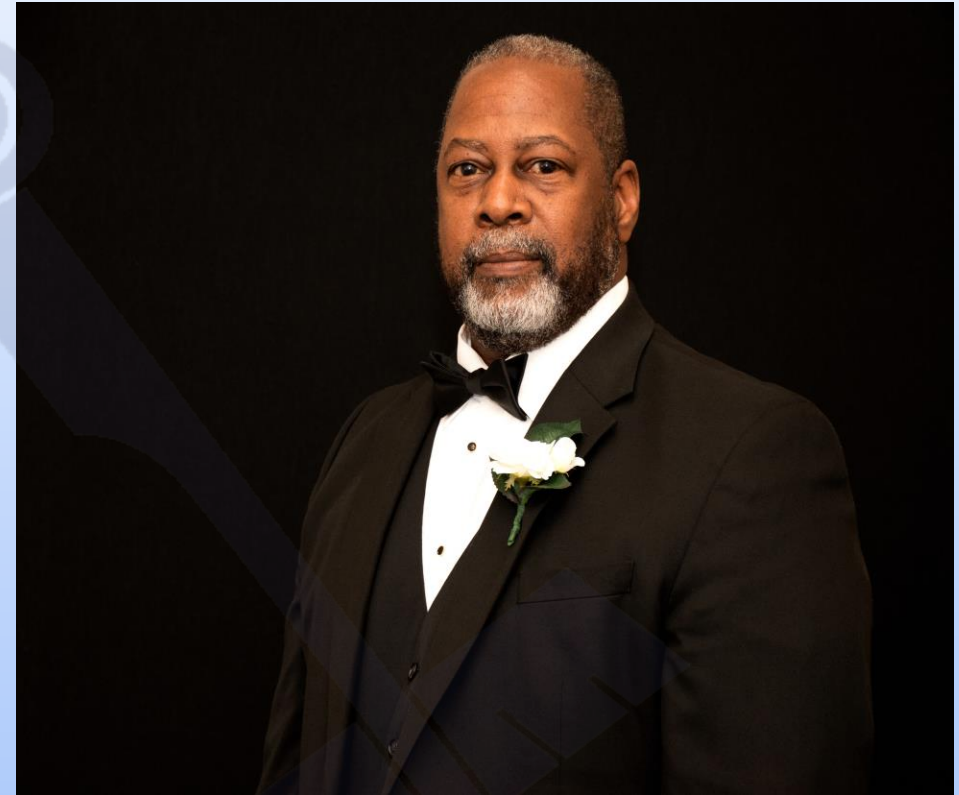

## Temple Terrace Lodge No.330 F. & A. M. Chartered 23 Apr 1959 History



Temple Terrace Lodge was founded under dispensation on Sept 2nd 1958. The Charter was granted on April 23rd 1958 and delivered to the Lodge by RW Harley S. Miller DDGM of the 20th Masonic District. The Lodge set to work on Sept 19th 1958, was consecrated and constituted on June 12th 1958 in the Temple Terrace Civic Center.

In December 1964 the Lodge was notified that meetings could no longer be held in the Civic Center. Dispensation was obtained from the Grand Lodge of Florida to move the Charter to meet with Community Lodge No. 292 at 1800 W. Waters Ave.

Through good financial management the Lodge was able to purchase land identified as lot 14 W.E. Hammers Estates on April 23 1965 for the sum of \$7500. Now that the site had been established, enthusiasm and hard work of a small number of Brothers sparked membership to start funding drives and start construction plans. The Building Committee consisting of Worshipfuls Oscar Weeks Sr, Lynn Blich, James Hamilton Jr, James H. Howard, and Brothers Milton W. Church, Frank B. Moses submitted building plans to the Grand Lodge Properties Committee and proposed a loan of \$15000.



## Temple Terrace Lodge No.330 F. & A. M. Chartered 23 Apr 1959 History



Construction started on Nov 12th 1966 with the ground breaking ceremony presided over by Most Worshipful William Hollis. He stated this effort was an example of Masonry at work and Masonry on the move. The loan and plans were approved on April 14th 1967. The Grand Lodge approved to move the Charted to the building site location with the first meeting being held on June 16th 1967 with James P, Hamilton Jr presiding as Worshipful Master. The New Lodge building was located at 11807 N 56th Street and dedicated on July 8th 1967 by MW John T. Rouse

During the period from 1973 to 1975 a major addition consisting of the present day dining room, kitchen and upstairs was completed.

During 2001 the remodel of the lodge room took place under Worshipful Master Dale McClellan. Brother Frank Harmon acted as the general contractor with Richard Fomuke (who later joined the lodge) and Brother Gary Tuttle as sub contractors. A new desk for the Treasurer and Secretary was built and donated by Worshipful Mike McCool and Worshipful David Rasmus.

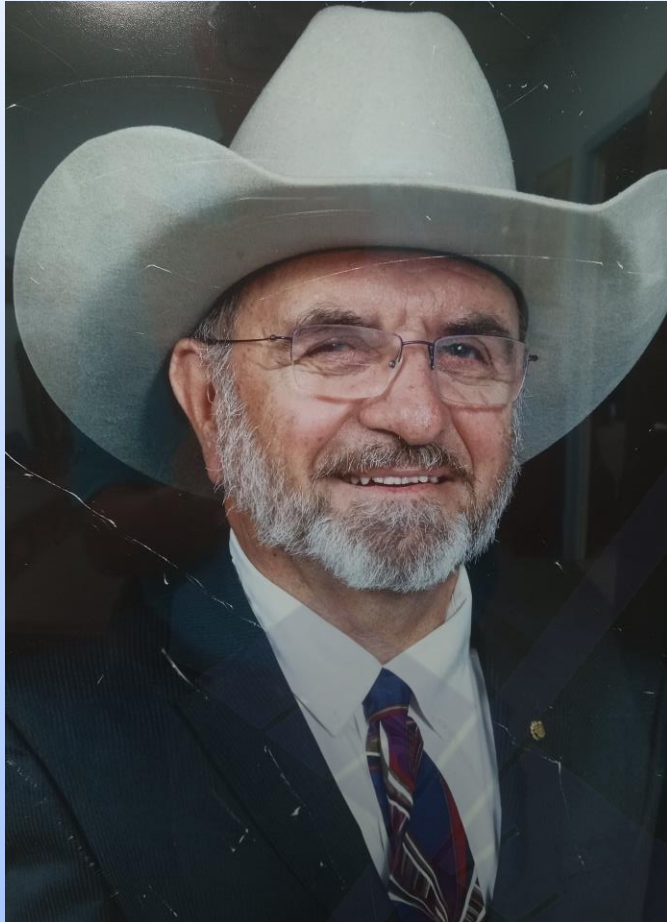

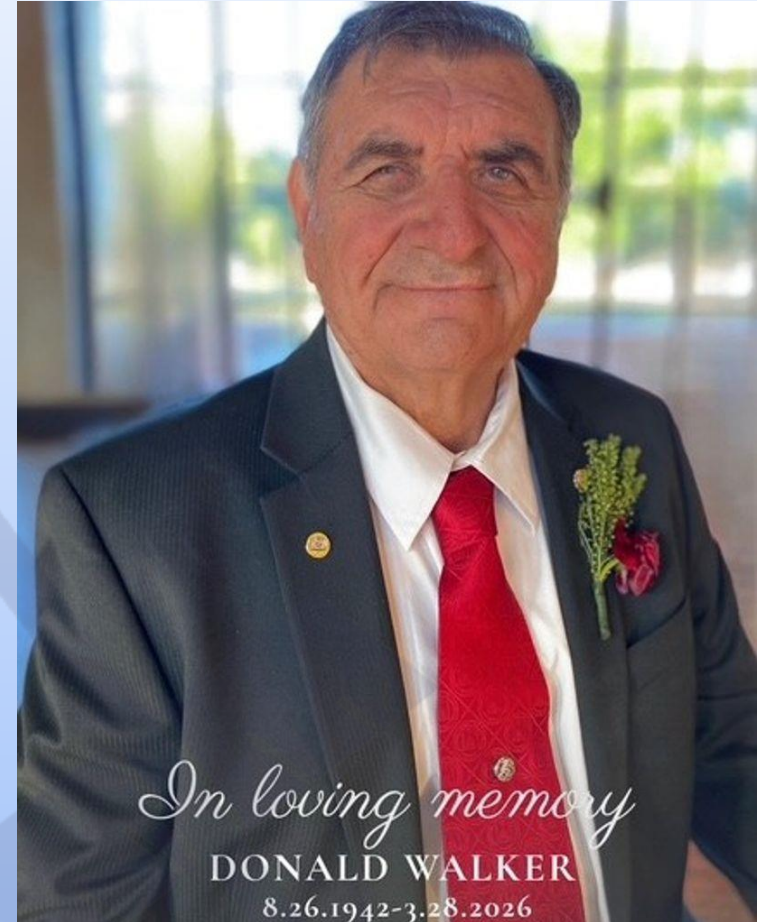
