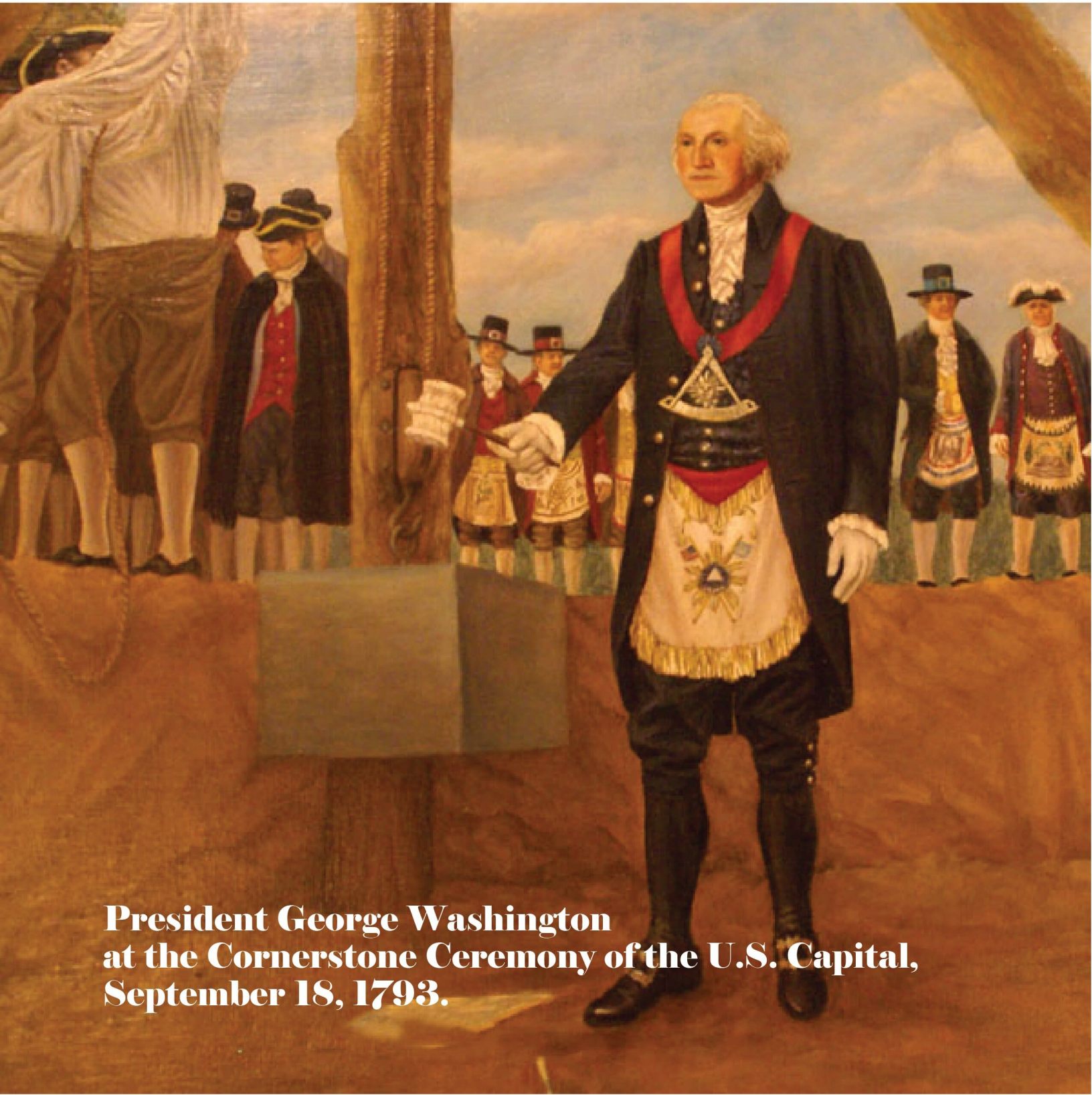

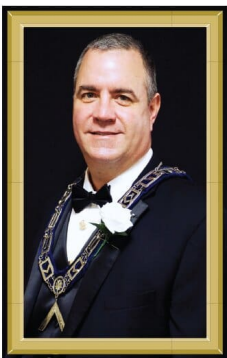

September 18, 1793.**

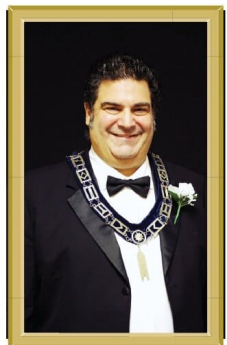

From The South



Freemasonry is Rich in history and it was on September 18, 1793 that the cornerstone of the U.S. Capitol was laid by three Masonic Lodges, Potomac Lodge No 9 and Federal Lodge No 15, under the Grand Lodge of Maryland and Alexandria Lodge No 22, under the Grand Lodge of Virginia with President George Washington presiding as "Acting Master" of the ceremony.

The items used at the Cornerstone Ceremony were as follows:

Silver Trowel with Ivory handle made by John Duffy owned by Alexandria-Washington Lodge No 22, Alexandria, Virginia.

Wood T-Square and Level own by Alexandria-Washington Lodge No 22, Alexandria, Virginia.

Marble Gavel with wood handle, made by John Duffy owned by Potomac Lodge No 5, Washington D.C.

It is generally accepted that Washington wore the Watson-Cassoul apron sent to him in 1783 to the ceremony. In 1812, Lawrence Lewis, nephew of Washington, gave it to Alexandria-Washington Lodge No 22, Alexandria, Virginia where it remains today.
